### Tournament Rules & Conditions

1. The Tournament is conducted under the R & A Rules of Golf.
2. The competition is open to members of the Professional Golfers' Association (Professionals and Assistants) and amateur players invited by the Tournament Organisers and Team Sponsors.
3. Teams may comprise four amateurs or one Professional and three amateurs.
4. The format will be an 18 hole Stableford competition. The aggregate of the team's two best net scores at each hole will be entered on the card.
5. Professionals will play off scratch. Amateur handicap allowance is 3/4.
6. **One player per team must play off a handicap of gross 9 or below, all other members of the team must play off a handicap of maximum gross 24 for men, maximum gross 30 for ladies. Depending upon the standard scratch scores of the course played, ladies will receive additional shots based on the SSS difference. For example Little Aston Golf Club, Men's Par is 72, SSS 73 and Ladies Par and SSS are 74 therefore 2 courtesy shots to ladies.**
7. Congu handicap certificates will be required on the day of the tournament.
8. Professionals' fees will be payable by the Tournament Organisers, as agreed with the PGA.
9. No amateur may win more than a total of £500 in prizes in accordance with R&A rules.
10. Players eligible for sponsored hole prizes should clearly ring their scores on the card for the attention of the PGA/Tournament Organisers and complete and submit the prize form provided by the PGA/Tournament Organisers immediately after their round.
11. In the event of a tie for first place, and other prize winning places, the result of the competition will be decided on the last 9,6 or 3 holes.
12. Range finding aids are permitted in this tournament.
13. The decision of the Tournament Organisers is final on matters concerning amateur players and the distribution of prizes.
