Tournament Rules & Conditions

- 1. The Tournament is conducted under the R & A Rules of Golf.
- 2. The competition is open to members of the Professional Golfers' Association (Professionals and Assistants) and amateur players invited by the Tournament Organisers and Team Sponsors.
- 3. Teams may comprise four amateurs or one Professional and three amateurs.
- 4. The format will be an 18 hole Stableford competition. The aggregate of the team's two best net scores at each hole will be entered on the card.
- 5. Professionals will play off scratch. Amateur handicap allowance is 85%.
- 6. One player per team must play off a handicap of gross 9 or below, all other members of the team must hold a handicap of maximum gross 24 for men, maximum gross 30 for ladies. Ladies will play off the red tees and own stroke index.
- 7. Professionals' fees will be payable by the Tournament Organisers.
- 8. No amateur may win more than a total of £500 in prizes in accordance with R & A rules. Winning teams need to be present at the prize-giving in the evening.
- 9. In the event of a tie for first place, and other prize winning places, the result of the competition will be decided on the last 9,6 or 3 holes.
- 10. Range finding aids are permitted in this tournament.
- 11. The decision of the Tournament Organisers is final on matters concerning amateur players and the distribution of prizes.
