Tournament Rules & Conditions

1. The Tournament is conducted under the R & A Rules of Golf.
2. The competition is open to members of the Professional Golfers' Association (Professionals and Assistants) and amateur players invited by the Tournament Organisers and Team Sponsors.
3. Teams may comprise four amateurs or one Professional and three amateurs.
4. The format will be an 18 hole Stableford competition. The aggregate of the team's two best net scores at each hole will be entered on the card.
5. Professionals will play off scratch.
6. The Second City Golf Classic prides itself on its strict policy regarding the playing handicaps of the amateur golfers, ensuring fairness for all teams. To do this:
  - Players must have a Handicap Index® that was issued from a 'golf club' (as defined in the WHS Rules of Handicapping).
  - Amateur golfers will receive 85% of their course handicap, with a maximum course handicap limit of 24 for men, 36 for ladies. If your Course Handicap exceeds the above limits then you will lose your extra shots and play of 24 (men) or 36 ladies.
  - Teams that are made up of 4 amateurs (no professional) have to meet the following added criteria. One amateur in the team must hold an WHS handicap index of 7.5 or better, a 7.5 index off the white tees at Little Aston Golf Club (Host Venue) equates to a course handicap of 9.
7. The professionals will play for a Prize fund that will be published when the start times are issued. There will be a guaranteed £1000 1st prize cheque for the leading professional, as well as the Dick Greenhalgh trophy. A £50 entry/donation to the Prostate Cancer Charity will be taken from every professional playing.
8. No amateur may win more than a total of £750 in prizes in accordance with R&A rules. Winning teams need to be present at the prize-giving in the evening.
9. In the event of a tie for first place, and other prize winning places, the result of the competition will be decided on the last 9,6 or 3 holes.
10. Range finding aids are permitted in this tournament.
11. The decision of the Tournament Organisers is final on matters concerning amateur players and the distribution of prizes.
